Ride times will be sent via email unless otherwise specified. You may send your entry any time after the opening date and entries must be postmarked no later than closing date.

**Refunds:** Up to closing date, all fees are refundable except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from a wait list. During the competition no refunds including 'Acts of God 'will be issued. **Office fee is non-refundable.** 

**Awards:** Ribbons to  $4^{th}$  place. Management reserves the right to break ties. There will also be a High Point Overall award for the rider with the highest score regardless of level. There will be no separate Divisions for this show – we are all one big family!

If Rider or a member of the group feels sick, please stay home!

## **Class Information**

Intro and Basic tests will be held in the small arena (20 m x 40 m). All other tests will be held in the large arena (20 m x 60 m).

We reserve the right to combine, split or cancel classes based on entries.

Classes are Western Dressage Classes per United States Equestrian Federation. Gaited horses are included, and shall be judged according to WDAA rules.

You may enter any class you wish. You may enter multiple classes; however, you cannot ride in two non-consecutive levels (i.e. Intro and Level 2). We recommend that you keep your entries to a maximum of four classes per day. Test Of Choice classes: can be any of the WDAA Western Dressage Tests. Please specify which test (example: WD Level 2 Test 4) you wish to compete.

Class schedule will not be in order of the class list but rather based on entries. Specific ride time(s) will be emailed to you before the show. Please make sure your entry is filled out legibly, especially your e-mail address so you can receive your ride times via email prior to the show.

## **Competition Rules**

**Numbers:** You will be provided with a bridle/halter number for each horse/rider combination. Horses must always have a bridle number attached when outside of their stall.

**Tests:** We will be using the 2022 WDAA/USEF Western Dressage tests, which are available at <a href="https://www.westerndressageassociation.org">www.westerndressageassociation.org</a>.

Attire and Equipment: An ASTM safety helmet is required for Western Dressage competitors UNDER the age of 18 at all times when riding. Proper footwear is required for all competitors.

We hope to have a knowledgeable person on the grounds to advise on the proper attire, equipment, tack, rules. This is truly a Schooling/Educational show.

**Dogs:** No dogs are allowed on the premises.

**Hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accident Policy:** Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

**Other:** Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules and of the current USEF/WDAA rules will be judged in accordance therewith.

## Entries, Scheduling, and Scoring

### An Entry is Complete when:

- Current (within one year of show date) negative Coggins test
- All horses traveling from out of state must have a health certificate dated within 30 days of horses' arrival at the show as well as a copy of a negative Coggins test dated within the 12 months of the show date and a current vaccination record. Your health certificate will be checked at the stalling office.
- The Liability form must be signed by Rider/Owner/Trainer.
- All fees must be paid

All information must be received before entering show grounds. Thank You!

• All grooms, family, assistants, etc., who will be on the Grounds during the show must sign the Liability Release when arriving at the venue.

Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on postmark/electronic submission date. Entries may be limited.

Late entries are accepted on a space-available basis and charged a \$30/entry late fee.

If classes are oversubscribed, a "wait list" will be maintained. Horses will be moved into the show based on wait list order prior to scheduling. After the show has been timed, show secretary will work wait list horses to get them into the show based on the best fit with the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

## **Scheduling**

Ride Conflicts: Competitors with multiple horses and horses with multiple riders are urged to bring enough help. If a conflict is discovered, notify the show secretary immediately.

#### **Official Ride Times**

Acknowledgements: Entries will be acknowledged via email upon receipt by the show secretary. **Provisional Ride Times:** Provisional ride times will be emailed. **Day Sheet:** Be certain to check the day sheet, which will be posted near the indoor arena.

#### **Scores**

Tests will be scored and posted outside the show office. It is the responsibility of the competitor to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day.

Tests and ribbons are available after the class is completed. Please allow at least 30 minutes from the class's last ride time before sending designated person to pick them up.

## **Stabling**

Please stop at the show office to obtain your stall assignments and bridle numbers and sign Liability Release prior to unloading. We request that stalls be arranged for in advance of the show.

Early Arrival and Extended Stay: On the entry form please indicate your arrival and departure dates if you are reserving stalls. A scheduled arrival time may need to be arranged and an additional day stall fees may apply.

#### Arena

• **The indoor arena** will be available for warm up and getting horses accustomed to the surroundings on Friday afternoon/evening AFTER THE RIDE A TEST CLINIC UNTIL 7 PM.

• Maximum three people inside the dressage arena at a time; others may warm up outside the dressage arena until space is available.

### NO LUNGEING IN THE INDOOR ARENA.

**Warm-up and lunging arenas:** Warm up and lunging areas will be available outside before and during the show.

## **Facility Location and Parking**

**Directions:** Take I-25 to the Exit for Wheatland, Wyoming (Exit 78 coming North on I-25). Turn East on West Mariposa Parkway toward Wheatland. Turn Left onto South 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn Left onto HIGH TOWER Street. Continue onto Orchard Road. Turn Left onto Sybille Creek Road. Destination is on the right.
